

The committee held its regular monthly meeting on Monday June 27. We thanked Laurence Alexander, who has represented the Tennis Club very effectively on the committee but now feels he should relinquish this commitment. The Tennis Club will be finding a successor.

Some modest progress has been made in improving the website - watch this space!

We will be carrying out a village survey in connection with the planned improvements and refurbishment of the hall, and are looking - so far without success - for a volunteer to help organise this for us. A structural survey of the hall has been carried out, showing that it is basically sound, with no underlying problems. This clears the way for us to develop a prioritised programme of work, and a proposed programme will be presented at the next meeting. It was agreed that the first thing would be to ensure that the roof was completely sound (including, possibly, providing a pitched roof to replace the present flat roof over the kitchen), and estimates will be obtained for this project.

The field mower tractor had recently been vandalised. Attempts had been made to report this to the Police, but it had proved impossible to make contact. Fortunately, our volunteers have succeeded in getting the tractor going again, so that the field can be regularly mown, as usual.
