

Beckford Community Village Hall

The committee held its regular monthly meeting on Monday May 23. We welcomed Anne Worrall as the new representative of Beckford Parish Council, and expressed thanks to Diane Colvin, whom Anne was replacing.

We want to improve the village hall website, and have now specified the changes in wording and photographs which we would like to see. It now remains to be seen if this can be achieved through our present methods of uploading information, or whether we shall need some professional support.

Regarding the proposed hall refurbishment, the Survey Sub-Committee is looking at the list of people who offered to help when the 2013 survey was carried out. When the time comes for a survey, we shall be recommending which of the options identified (do nothing, rebuild, refurbish, extend) the committee favours. However, action on the survey will await the completion of the forthcoming structural survey. In the shorter term, minor improvements to the appearance of the front of the hall will be undertaken soon.

Our fields are proving very popular with caravanners, and we now have nine bookings for 2017, with one for Easter 2018 already requested. In response to some queries, it has been made clear to caravanners that BCVH Ltd is not VAT registered, and that therefore all fees are without VAT.
